Memorandum of Association.
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1. The name of the Society shall be "SAMAJ BIKHHAN KENDRA"
2. The Registered ^{office} of the society shall be situated at -
7, Nandy Street : Calcutta - 700029.
3. The objects for which the society is established are :-
 - a) To establish, run maintain or manage, takeover 'Old Age Home' for men and women : Orphanages for boys and girls, schools, libraries, hospitals, health-centres, dispensaries, hostels for men and women, youth centres, community centres, production oriented training centres of cottage and small-scale industries, vocational training centres, adult education centres, dairies, piggeries, poultry farms etc. etc. for the benefit of the distressed and backward people in rural and urban areas of India.
 - b) To arrange and organise selling counters, shops etc. of cottage and small scale industries and vocational training centres run by the Kendra at the terms and conditions laid down by the Governing Body of the Kendra.
 - c) To organise and arrange lectures, debates, discussions, Seminars and excursions for the diffusion of knowledge among the masses of India.
 - d) To publish or cause to publish useful literatures, papers, Magazines, books, journals etc.
 - e) To organise orientation course for the people living in India abroad so as to educate them about the tradition and trends of Indian culture and nationhood.
 - f) To promote and encourage advancement of literary, cultural, scientific and Technical education.
To help needy students of all communities for the purpose of prosecution of studies.
 - h) To establish, organise and run training centres, production oriented training centres for physically and mentally handicapped persons of the country.

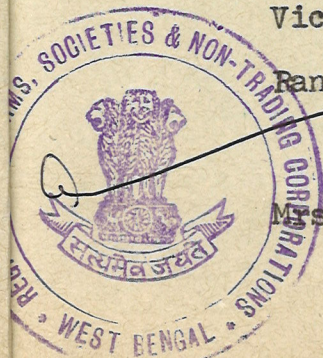
- i) To alleviate the sufferings of animals.
 - j) To encourage the people and to take necessary steps for planting trees in rural and urban areas of the country.
 - k) To collect and preserve manuscripts, painting, sculptures, works of art, antiques, technical and mechanical and scientific, instruments.
 - l) To engage and assist in such other philanthropic activities as may be deemed appropriate by the Governing Body of the Kendra.
 - m) To acquire, purchase, take on lease or rent on terms and conditions approved by the Governing Body any movable and immovable properties (land, building, room, furniture, technical or scientific apparatus, books, machineries, livestock etc.) for the purpose of the Kendra in anywhere in India
 - n) To construct, maintain, improve, develop, and alter any buildings, houses, sheds and other works necessary or convenient for the
 - o) To receive aids, donations, helps in cash or in kind from sympathetic persons and organisations for the purpose of the Kendra.
 - p) To appoint and dismiss (subject to approval of the Governing Body) for the purpose of the Kendra.
 - q) To open, run and manage Branch offices, centres of different activities of the Kendra (subject to approval of the Governing Body) in any where in India.

Rules of the Association



GENERAL MEETING

There shall be two kinds of General Meeting (a) Annual General Meeting (b) Special General Meeting.

2. The Sangstha shall hold an Annual General Meeting once in every year and not more than 15 months shall lapse between two successive General Meetings. At least 14 days notice specifying the time, place, the day and hour shall be given to every member of the Sangstha but under certificate of posting letters.

3. No business will be transacted at any meetings unless there is quorum or 15 members present at the commencement of the meeting.

4. The business to be transacted at the Annual General Meeting shall be :

(a) To confirm the minutes of the last annual general meeting and of special general meeting if any.

(b) To adopt with or without modifications of the report of the workings of the Sangstha for the previous ended.

(c) To pass audited accounts for the said Meeting .

(d) To appoint qualified Auditor/Auditors.

(e) To elect members of the Governing Body.

(f) To pass the Budget of the next year.

5. A special general meeting shall be convened by the Secretary if two third members of the Sangstha requisitioned such meeting specifying the nature of the business to be transacted at the meeting. On receipt of such notice the Secretary shall hold such meeting within 21 days.

In default by the Secretary, requisitionists shall hold such meeting and no business other than the specified business shall be transacted in that meeting.

DUTIES OF OFFICE BEARERS.

1. President :-

(a) He shall preside over all meetings of the Sangstha.

(b) Advise the Sangstha on all points of disputes and generally look after the interest of the Sangstha.

(c) Take all disciplinary actions such as removal, dismissal etc. in consultation with the Governing Body.

2. Vice-President :

(a) He shall preside over all meetings in absence of the President.

(b) Advise the Sangstha on all points of disputes and generally look after the interests of the Sangstha.

3. General-Secretary :

(a) He shall convene General Meeting and Meetings of the Governing Body of the Sangstha.

(b) Sign on behalf of the Sangstha all receipts for all sums received as subscription, donation loan, rent, etc.



- (c) Sign and give pay order or bills for payment &
- (d) Transact all other business subject to the direction of the Governing Body.

4. Treasurer :

- (a) He shall collect and receive all sorts of subscriptions, donations and deposit money and grant receipts therefor.
- (b) Maintain and keep cash Book and such other accounts as are necessary.

5.

- (a) They shall convene all meetings of the Sangstha except General Meetings.
- (b) Issue general circulars and notices.
- (c) Receive all applications for Membership of the Sangstha which shall be placed to the Governing Body
- (d) Transact all other businesses subject to the direction of the Governing Body.

TRUSTEES

- (a) There shall be five Trustees of the Sangstha to be appointed by the Governing Body from amongst the members of the Sangstha or from other persons of eminence, high rank and reputation who may not be members of the Sangstha in whom all or any properties or funds of the Sangstha will be vested and will remain so till life.
- (b) Any three of the Trustees shall be entitled to exercise all or any of the powers and functions of all Trustees.
- (c) In case of death or resignation of any Trustee the Governing Body shall appoint a new Trustee in the place.
- (d) No Trustee or Trustees in whom for the time being the properties of the Sangstha will be vested shall be answerable for any loss or damage in the administration or application of the trust and fund unless such loss or damage shall happen by or through the wilful default or neglect of the Trustee or Trustees.

DISSOLUTION OF THE SANGSTHA

The Sangstha may be dissolved by a resolution to that effect passed by three fifth of the members of the Sangstha at a General Meeting.

The said meeting shall also decide the manner of disbursement of the funds and assets of the Sangstha if any after dissolution.

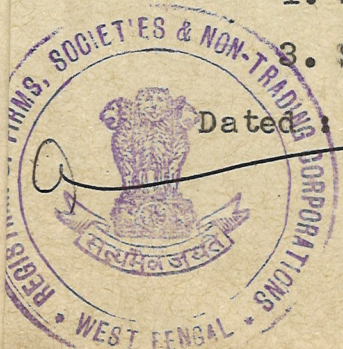

Article of Association

MEMBERSHIP

1. Qualification :

Any person who has attained the age of 18 years and who agrees in writing to be bound by the Memorandum and Regulations of the Society.

2. Class of Members :

(a) Patrons (b) Life Members (c) Founder Members
(d) Ordinary Members (e) Honorary Members.

(a) Patrons : Any person, ~~qualified to be a member, paying~~ ~~ing~~ of high social standard and reputation treated to be very much helpful to the Association by the Governing Body may be admitted as a Patron.

(b) Life Members : Any person, qualified to be a member, paying or having paid a sum of Rs. 500/- shall be elected a Life Member of the society by the Governing Body.

(c) Founder Members : The following persons shall be the founder members of the and will remain so till life and will be entitled to all rights and privileges of membership

(v) Sibaprosad Chatterjee 27 1/2 A, Elgin Road, Cal - 20.

(d) Ordinary Members : Any person, qualified to be member, paying ordinary membership fee of Rs. 24/- per annum, may be admitted as Ordinary Member of the Society (Sanstha).

(e) Honorary Members : Any person, qualified to be a member, whose connection with the society is deemed to be necessary by the founder members, may with the consent of such persons, be elected as Honorary of this Sanstha.

3. Cessation of Membership :-

Any ~~member~~ member shall cease to be a member - (a) On his resignation from membership by a letter addressed to the Secretary of the Sanstha, (b) On his becoming insane or insolvent (c) On his conviction of any offence.

Ordinary Membership will be automatically ceased due to default of subscription before the Annual General Meeting Notice.

4. Register of Members : The Sanstha shall maintain a Register of Members containing the names, addresses and their occupations, the date of cessation. The Register will be kept open for inspection of the members of the society on requisition.

5. Rights and obligations of members : (a) any member of the society has the right to elect and to be elected in any election of the society. (b) To submit suggestion for discussion to the Governing Body and sub-committee on any matter. (c) To inspect the accounts of the society on appointment with the secretary.



GOVERNING BODY

5.1. There shall be a Governing Body consisting of not less than 25 members and will be composed of the Founder members. Elected members shall be elected at the Annual General Meeting.

The office-bearers of the Governing Body shall consist of President, Vice-Presidents, (not more than three) Treasurer, General Secretary, Secretaries (not more than two). The office-bearers shall be elected by the Governing Body from among themselves on the day of Annual Meeting.

5.2. The termination of Membership : A member of the Governing Body shall cease to be a member of the Governing Body if (a) he/she resigned by a letter addressed to the Secretary of the Sangstha.

5.3. Meeting : A meeting of the Governing Body shall be held at least once in three months at such a place and time as the President and General Secretary may determine. Seven Members will make the QUORUM.

5.4. Notice : Seven days' notice of the meeting specifying the place, date, time and the general nature of work and business to be transacted shall be given to every member of the Governing Body. Emergency meeting may be called on 24 hours' notice.

5.5. Procedure of the meeting : The President or in his absence the Vice-President shall preside over all meetings of the Governing Body and in their absence members present shall elect a Chairman of the meeting. All questions before the meeting will be decided by a majority of votes. No business will be transacted at any meeting unless there is a quorum of seven members present at the commencement of business.

6. Powers and duties of the Governing Body : The Governing Body shall have general power of supervision and conduct over all the affairs of the Sangstha and in particular shall discharge the following duties :-

- (i) To summon the Annual General Meeting of the Sangstha.
- (ii) To appoint sub-committee with such powers and duties as may considered necessary and expedient.
- (iii) To accept donation, gift, subscription, movable or immovable properties for the objects of the Sangstha.
- (iv) To sell, lease, mortgage or otherwise dispose of and deal with all or any part of the property of the Sangstha as deemed necessary or expedient for the purpose of the Sangstha.
- (v) To keep proper accounts of the Sangstha and to open Bank accounts in the name of the Sangstha. Bank accounts will be operated by the Treasurer jointly with the President or the General Secretary of the Sangstha.

SAFE CUSTODY OF FUNDS.

1. The Governing or the Trustees of the Sangstha shall be responsible for the safe custody of the funds and assets of the Sangstha.

2. The funds of the Sangstha shall be kept in Scheduled Banks..
