- To promote confidence, discipline, moral values and overall personality development.

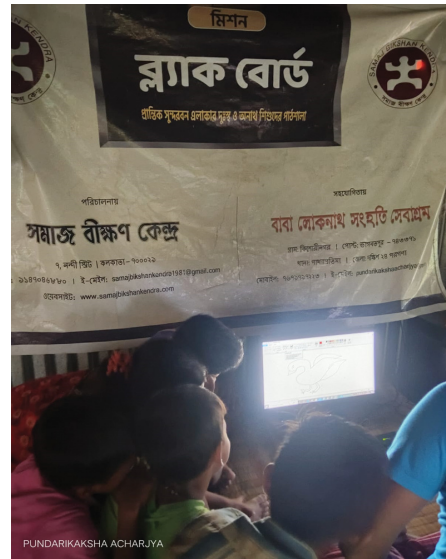
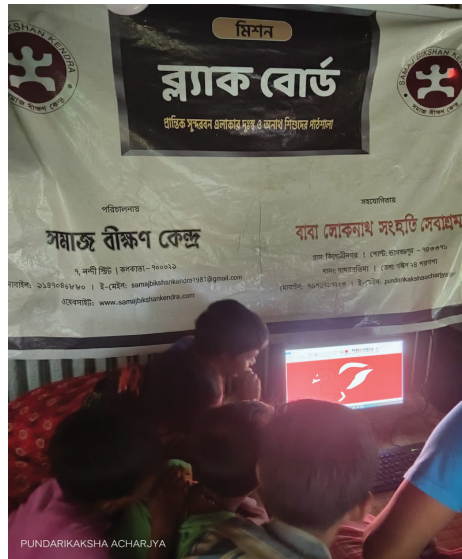
Project Centres

“Mission – Black Board” is currently operating through **two educational centres**:

1. Kishorinagar Centre

- **Location:** Kishorinagar, South 24 Parganas
- **Implementing Partner:** Baba Lokenath Sanghati Sevasram
- **Number of Children:** 28





The Kakdwip centre caters to children from poor families and orphaned children living in nearby villages. The centre supports their educational needs and encourages regular school attendance while fostering personal growth.

2. Kolkata Centre

- **Location:** Kolkata
- **Implementing Partner:** South Corner Sporting Club
- **Number of Children:** 32





The Kolkata centre serves children from economically weaker sections residing in the surrounding neighbourhoods. The centre provides a safe and encouraging environment where students receive academic assistance and personal guidance.

Beneficiaries

The project currently benefits a total of **60 children**, comprising:

- **Kishorinagar Centre** : 28 Children
- **Kolkata Centre** : 32 Children

The beneficiaries are drawn from the surrounding communities of both centres and belong primarily to economically disadvantaged families. Many of these children face financial and social barriers that limit their access to quality education.

Project Activities

“Mission – Black Board” conducts a range of educational and developmental activities including:

- Supplementary academic coaching;
- Homework assistance;
- Basic literacy and numeracy support;
- Personality development sessions;
- Moral and value-based education;
- Educational motivation and counselling;
- Community engagement with parents and guardians;

These activities are designed to complement formal schooling and help children build confidence, improve academic performance and develop essential life skills.

Community Partnership

The success of “Mission – Black Board” is made possible through the active collaboration of local community organisations:

- **Baba Lokenath Sanghati Sevasram**, South 24 Parganas, supports the implementation and management of the Kishorinagar centre.
- **South Corner Sporting Club**, Kolkata, provides support for the operation of the Kolkata centre.

These partnerships strengthen community participation and ensure that educational services reach children who need them most.

Impact

“Mission – Black Board” has created a positive educational environment for underprivileged children by:

- Providing regular educational support to 60 children.
- Encouraging consistent school attendance.
- Improving students' learning abilities and academic confidence.
- Creating a safe and inclusive learning space.
- Promoting equal educational opportunities for children from disadvantaged backgrounds.
- Building stronger community involvement in child education.

Future Plans

“Mission – Black Board” aims to further strengthen and expand its impact by:

- Increasing student enrolment at both centres.
- Enhancing educational resources and learning materials.
- Introducing digital learning facilities.
- Organising health, nutrition, and life-skills awareness programmes.
- Mobilising volunteers and community educators.
- Developing partnerships with educational institutions, CSR initiatives and philanthropic organisations to ensure long-term sustainability.
